

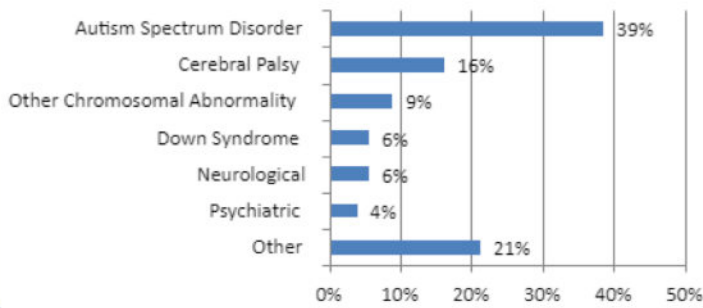


SIRE provides a community where horses help people with disabilities and challenges to live their best life.

Program Highlights

SIRE provided over 5300 service hours to 266 unduplicated clients through a combination of our weekly Therapeutic Riding (TR) program (179 clients, 4606 hours), the Equine-Assisted Learning (EAL) program (87 students, 544 hours), the veterans program, and the competition program. From our annual survey, 100% report they benefited physically, emotionally/psychologically, or socially from Therapeutic Riding, and 88% of clients report that SIRE has been the best activity of all the various therapies and activities they have tried.
